VEGETABLES (Classes 1-10 must be same variety)

1. 3 onions
2. 5 shallots
3. 3 beetroot – stems not to exceed 3"
4. 3 carrots – stems not to exceed 3"
5. 5 runner beans
6. 3 potatoes
7. 5 climbing/dwarf French beans
8. 3 tomatoes – not cherry – with calyx
9. 5 cherry tomatoes or similar cultivars – with calyx
10. 2 courgettes – max. size 8"
11. 1 cucumber
12. Any other veg. not mentioned
13. Heaviest marrow/courgette
14. Longest runner bean
15. Misshapen vegetable (with description)
16. Collection 4 different veg. displayed on board (18" square board supplied)
17. Potatoes in container – entrants already issued with potatoes.

FRUIT

18. Dish fruit - with stone (not mixed)
19. Dish any other fruit or 3 if larger fruit (not mixed)

FLOWERS All plant material must be grown by exhibitor unless stated otherwise

20. Vase fresh flowers (annuals/perennials) no shrubs/ foliage. **Max.** overall size ht.18" x 16"
21. 3 dahlias- any species
22. Table decoration display. Can include bought material. Max ht.10" Length 18" width 6"
Silver theme – “25th Annual Show”
23. 1 perfect flower
24. Specimen rose can be multi headed but on one stem
25. Foliage only arrangement display. Max. ht. 12"from table, max width 12"
26. Vase sweet peas
