

# RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

Eligibility to enter is confined to amateurs who either are residents of, or work within Woolhampton their children or grandchildren, and also residents of Midgham. All pupils of Woolhampton School are eligible to enter in children's classes

All exhibits must be the property of, and grown by or made by, the exhibitors unless stated otherwise

Only one entry per person per class is allowed. All entries must be submitted on the printed entry form

The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry

The exhibits (except for Class 17) must be staged between 9.30 and 11.45 am on the day of the Show. No exhibits may be removed from Show tables before 3.15 pm

Prizes will be withheld or modified if the exhibits are considered undeserving of the prize offered. When only 1 entry in class, prize will be at judges' discretion.

The decision of the judges shall be final as to the relative merits of the exhibits and the decision of the Committee shall be final in all other matters. No exhibitors or members of the public will be allowed in the Hall between 12 and 2 pm

Small monetary prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> (£1), 2<sup>nd</sup> (60p) & 3<sup>rd</sup> (40p). If there are three or fewer entries in a class, only 1<sup>st</sup> prize will be awarded; if there are four entries, only 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> will be awarded

When only one entry in a class, prize will be at judges' discretion'

## GUIDANCE NOTES

- Remember dirty vegetables lose points
- Onion tops may be tied or whipped using raffia or string
- When specific numbers are required, any variance could result in disqualification
- Runner & French beans should have some stalk attached
- Fruit should be displayed on their stalks and with natural bloom
- If covering food exhibits, use cling film **NOT** foil. Cake covers are provided.
- Jars for jam, etc., should be plain (about 450gr size) and no brand names on lid
- All vases, dishes, etc., to be supplied by the exhibitor unless stated otherwise
- Photos to be UNMOUNTED and no larger than **7" by 5" or a standard panoramic print**
- When entering 4-on-a-board class please refer to vegetable score sheet available on website or on request

**Arthur Dollin Trophy** – for best exhibit in vegetable section (except 16 or 17)

**Brian Chick Cup** – for best entry on board – class 16

**Christine Raban Cup** – for best floral exhibit

**Jenny Franklin Cup** – for specimen rose exhibit

**LPC Shield** – for best entry in cookery section

**Sunflower mug** – for tallest sunflower

NB. Only potatoes bought from the Show Organisers are eligible. Container to be brought to Hall car park between **9 and 11 am** on the morning of the Show, foliage removed, where the potatoes will be tipped out and weighed by Show Judges (whose decision is final).
